As you decide on how to make your annual Lenten commitment to prayer, fasting and almsgiving, here are some ideas in the Parish to deepen your prayer life:

#### DAILY MASS

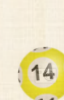

Congratulations to Maeve O'Doherty who was our weekly winner of our lotto on the 6<sup>th</sup> March 2025.

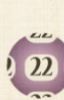


CURRENT JACKPOT: €2,000
